

SCHEDULE 8: GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATIONS (GDPR)

1. The Universities Pool Council (UPC) uses data to run tournaments which promote the sport of Pool at Higher Education institutions in the United Kingdom and Ireland, and exists for the benefit of players at this level. This data is only used to contact institutions players and officials regarding their participation at our events and to promote the sport of Pool at Higher Education institutions, and is not used for any other purpose.
2. At all times, we will treat the information you provide in the strictest confidence and in line with current data protection legislation. Your personal details will only be known to those directly involved in running UPC tournaments. Your details will not be shared with any third parties.
3. The UPC collects personal data that is provided by consent via third party entry forms such as BUCScore. By entering our event, you agree to the UPC using your personal data to run the event that has been entered. This information provides names of individuals and institutions of study, which are used to generate published draws during the events which the UPC runs. This information may also include individual contact details, which may be provided to accommodation suppliers if accommodation is booked by the UPC for the event entered. These contact details are only used in exceptional circumstances such as an emergency or if players need to be urgently contacted regarding the event. These contact details are not used for any other purpose than to conduct the event for which they are entered into and will not be shared with any other third parties.
4. Information may also be collected from individuals such as institution club committees or team captains to promote the sport of Pool at Higher Education institutions, and may include contact details such as e-mail addresses which we will send information to periodically.
5. Your data will be stored securely by those directly involved in running UPC tournaments and retained until the running of the events that they were collected for are completed.
